

Meeting minutes

30 June 2024 2pm

The meeting was held via zoom with 11 people in attendance. Those in attendance were, Seneshal, Deputy Seneshal, Exchequer, Deputy Exchequer, Minister of Arts and Science, Chatelaine, Knight's Marshal, Baroness of Scared Stone, and other members of the populace.

Old business included the topic of the canton Sew In, which was an Arts and Science event, coupled with a yard sale. 27 people attended the event and it was deemed very successful. Another Sew In event is planned for June 14th of 2025. A vote was taken to pay site fee of \$100 and passed with an 11-0 in favor.

The Exchequer position was handed down to deputy.

New business was conducted with the introduction of St. Urho's tournament to be held on the 15th of March 2025. A site was referenced at the local 3520 union hall between Cleveland and Statesville. Lease agreement and site fees were to be researched, and the discussion was tabled.

Financial policy was discussed and a vote was taken to accept the current policy with the caveat of updates/ changes to be made at the next business meeting. The vote was 6-2 in favor of accepting the current financial policy.

Autumn jubilee was discussed, with the date to be set for October the 5th and 6th. It will be considered a Baronial Revel.

Old Business-

Saint Urho's tourney was discussed, with completion of some of the items on the bid form. Hotel accommodation was noted as a necessary resource for out-of-town attendees. Site was secured at local 3520 union hall, between Cleveland and Statesville North Carolina.

The Autumn Jubilee needed fighting participants, with a note of rapier fighters contributing on Saturday, with Heavy fighters contributing on Sunday. A need for Arts & Science items was requested for public display. Pewter casting was noted to be a major contribution to the demonstration, with the possible need for extra propane.

Financial policy update- The updates to the financial policy were tabled during the last canton meeting. A meeting is to be scheduled with the Kingdom Exchequer for further assistance. No time frame has been developed for the meeting.

New Business-
